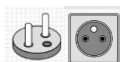

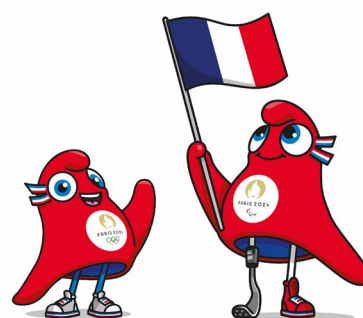

## MARSEILLE MARINA

The Paris 2024 team is pleased to announce that the Sailing Test Event is scheduled from **7 to 16 July** at Marseille Marina. This event, organised by Paris 2024, is part of the Paris 2024 testing Program. The Sailing Test Event will be located in the **Marina of Marseille, 2 promenade Georges Pompidou, 13008, Marseille**.

This competition is the initial opportunity for sailors of all Olympic classes to familiarise themselves with the future Olympic race waters, winds and currents, and test their skills on Marseille Marina.

For the test event, the focus is on operations for competitions. Therefore, there will be no public or broadcast service. Signage and visual displays with the Look of the Games will be ready for Games Time, so will the building under construction.

Test events are a vital part of an organising committee's preparations. It allows us to test our readiness and finetune the operational plans in order to be ready to host the competitions next year, in 2024. We also recognise that these events are very important in their own right, and our aim is to deliver technically excellent competitions. It will be a great opportunity to familiarise many more people with sailing, and even motivate some to take it up themselves. In terms of legacy, with one year to go until the Games, Paris 2024 is working hard with the city of Marseille to improve infrastructure and the water quality.

## PRE-COMPETITION INFORMATION

The Sailing Test Event is an invitation-only international event organised to receive the participation of around 52 countries.

### VEHICLES

Each nation will be allowed to leave only two vehicles on the parking, that you can use to enter and exit daily for shuttle purpose between your accommodation and the venue.

Extra vehicles are accepted but they will be parked close to the container park. Please note that those vehicles cannot be moved during the test event (single entry and single exit). Teams can access them freely every day, with a short walk.

The entrance of the trailer Park will be Gate C at the park Chanot, located 114 rond-point du Prado, 13008 Marseille, 5 min away by car from the venue. MNAs only park the trailer, for the whole competitions. All other vehicles cannot park there.

Slots will be provided for bikes at the seaside park near the container park, within Paris 2024 venue. Bicycles will not be allowed on the Marina (venue map p22).

### CONTAINERS

On-site, one container is allowed per nation. The logistic team will come back to the teams to give the delivery window within these dates:

- delivery and take down containers: 28 & 29 June
- spare delivery date: 30 June
- discharging of the containers available: 1st & 2<sup>nd</sup> July
- free access to the containers park on the operating hours: 3 to 16 July from 8:30 to 20:00
- lockdown: 4 & 5 July
- containers reloading: 17 July
- recollection: 18 & 19 July

Each nation needs to organize the transfer of the container (delivery/recollection). The organisation authority is in charge of handling the containers inside the containers park.

Each Member National Authorities (MNA) will have access to power and Wi-Fi.

### WATER LAUNCHING OF ATHLETES BOATS

For boats which arrive from the sea, make sure to get the accreditation first and to put it visible on the boat. For all boats which arrive by vehicles and trolley or in containers, MNAs should drive the trailers by hand from the container park to the boat park to go inside the Marina.

## ACCREDITATION

To edit accreditations, teams must have completed the Manage2sail information before 15<sup>th</sup> of June.

Accreditations must be collected at the Marina (at the pedestrian entrance of the Marina):

from June 30<sup>th</sup> to July 6<sup>th</sup>: 07:00 – 19:00

from July 7<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup>: 07:00 – 16:00

One representative of each nation can collect all the accreditations of the MNA.

To arrive at the Marina by the sea, with a boat, people need to put the accreditation visible. First, as pedestrian, they need to pick up the accreditation for the boat, before to come by the sea.

Access to the venue is not allowed without accreditation.

Personal accreditation must be visible at all times inside the venue.

## SECURITY PROCEDURE FOR SEA ENTRANCE

Boats entering the Marina need to have a visible accreditation sticker, provided by Paris 2024.

Control will be effective from 1<sup>st</sup> of July, and dedicated staff will check boats and passengers' accreditations.

## LATE WATER LAUNCHING

For MNAs arriving after 2<sup>nd</sup> of July by sea, water launching can be done either in Pointe Rouge or in Vieux-Port. Once the boat is launched, they can access the Marina by sea.

## EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

Equipment inspection will be held in Building 1 Measurement room and sailfloor. According to the Notice of race of the Sailing Test Event, this regatta is an international event for the purpose of RRS C1.1.

Boats shall be available for inspection in accordance with Notice of Race and the Equipment Inspection Schedule.

The procedures for inspections will be specified in the *Paris 2024 Test Event - Sailing Equipment Regulations*.

The fact that race officials may conduct inspections of a boat does not reduce the responsibilities of each competitor set out in the rules.

## PROVIDED EQUIPMENT

Every athlete will receive a tracker and stickers.

Trackers will also serve as daily sign in and sign out for the athlete. Therefore, they will have to collect them every day at the master cabin before competition starts and will have to return them to the same master cabin as soon as they arrive on land after racing. The Master Cabin will be in a temporary building in front of Building 2

Stickers will be delivered upon registration of the athlete to the racing authorities. Every athlete will receive their national letters on a bow sticker.

Each day, the three leaders of each fleet will obtain a "race leader dot" to collect from the race office until the medal races where they will be delivered during the ceremony.

Upon arrival and security check of their boats, the support team vessels will also receive a boat number (2 stickers to put on each side of the console).

Athletes who are competing for Formula kite and iQFOIL will receive bibs, at the Race Office at the venue.

The marks layers will not be equipped of GPS by the organisation, they are free of using the system they prefer.

## STORAGE FOR KITE AND IQFOIL

Storage tent will be accessible to store the material of kite and iQFOIL on the beach, during all the event periods.

## COMPETITION OPERATIONS

The regatta will consist of an opening series and, provided a minimum of 6 races have been completed in the opening series, a medal race or medal series. The top ten ranked boats at the end of the opening series of each event will progress to the medal race or medal series. The opening series may be extended if less than 6 races have been completed, with the marathon race counting as 2 races for the purposes of this clause. The format for each event will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

### FLAG LOFT

Launching signal flag can be either visible from the bridge for kite and windsurf or from the Marina Master Cabin for the rest of the events.

### REFUELLING

Refuelling of the support team vessels will be done at Pointe Rouge (43.24517°N - 5.36421°E) or at Vieux port (43.29489°N - 5.36468°E). The pump inside the marina is strictly reserved for race management boats.

### ATHLETES BOAT REPARATIONS

For all boat repairs, a special demand should be done to the Technical Committee during the competition from the 7<sup>th</sup> to the 16<sup>th</sup> of July

- during operating hours from 8:30 to 20:00, boats should be on the glais
- out of operating hours, take out the boat and bring it to the container park to work on it.

### WATER RESTRICTIONS

According to the decision of the local authorities, and due to the lack of rain, it is forbidden to rinse boats and equipment from water points available in the venue. These water points are only for drinking water and cannot be used for any other purpose. Athletes can still wash with the water they buy at the shops and bring themselves.

### PRE-COMPETITION TEAM MANAGERS' TECHNICAL MEETING

The technical meeting for team leaders is scheduled for 17:30 on 8 July 2023 in the building 2, adjacent to the Sport Information Desk. Member National Authorities shall sit in assigned seating and have one (1) or two (2) representatives at the technical meeting to complete their delegation's entry procedures and to approve their delegation's membership. At the Technical Meeting, Team Leaders will receive from Paris 2024 an athlete data checklist that needs to be completed and signed before the end of the meeting. To complete the checklist, the team leader will need to know the preferred name/s, date of birth and World Sailing Sailor ID for each of their athletes; please have this information with you.

### DAILY TEAM MANAGERS' MEETING

From 10 July to 16 July 2023, there will be a daily team leader meeting at 09:00 in Building 2, adjacent to the Sport Information Desk. Member National Authorities shall have no more than two (2) representatives at the daily team leaders' meetings. **The meeting agenda will vary each day but will always include a meteorological forecast** (venue map p22).



## DEDICATED SPACES

Athletes will have access to dedicated spaces:

- Changing rooms located in ground level Building 3
- Toilets at the Marina, in the changing rooms
- Toilets at the beach, near the container park
- Athletes lounge with light snacking located in ground level Building 2



## MEDICAL

Medical services will be available on-site from 7 July.

On water, there will be one first-aid boat per race area and one medical boat for the 4 race rounds available for training and competition.

On land, there will be one first-aid station with an ambulance, an emergency doctor, a nurse, a sports doctor, and a physiotherapist.

In case of emergency, there will be an ambulance on site, to transfer athletes to the designated hospital:

**AP-HM hospital de la Timone**, 264 rue Saint-Pierre, 13385 Marseille.

## DOPING CONTROL

Should Doping Control take place it will be conducted in accordance with the regulation of the World Sailing Anti-Doping Rules.

We encourage athletes and teams to be fully aware of World Sailing doping [rules](#). Sailors should communicate their planning to the anti-doping team upon request.

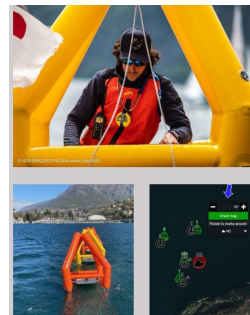
Minors must be accompanied by legal representant or adult to sign the doping control form.

## AUTONOMOUS MARKS

The organising authority will use self-positioning surface buoys able to maintain a fixed position or be moved remotely via web commands.

## LOST AND FOUND

Lost and found services will be available at the Accreditation centre, located by the pedestrian main entrance of the Marina.



## QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

- **Sun protection cream** is not provided at the venue.

### PONTOONS LIBERATION

After test event, MNAs must take out all the support team vessels outside the Marina on 17<sup>th</sup> July.

### CONTAINERS' PICK-UP AFTER TEST EVENT

Containers' pick-up will only be done at the end of the event, on the 18th and 19th of July.

Please note that, for safety reasons, no one can attend the collection of the container.

Please ensure with your transporter that no one from your nation is present on site for the pick-up.

## SERVICES

For athletes, all expenses regarding accommodation, transports and catering are covered by the teams.

### ACCOMMODATION

Teams are responsible for their own accommodation.

### TRANSPORTATION

Teams are responsible for their own transportation.

Every delegation can have 2 slots to park their vehicles in the organization parking.

### CATERING

Teams are responsible for their own catering for their breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Refreshments (only one coffee or tea, one cereal bars, one fruit per person per day) will be offered by Paris 2024 and available at the Athletes Lounge. A water bottle (gourd) will be offered to each athlete and there will be water fountains on site.

**FROM 7 TO 16 JULY 2023 ALL NAUTICAL ACTIVITIES (NAVIGATION, ANCHORAGE, SWIMMING, DIVING) ARE PROHIBITED FROM 8AM TO 8PM WITH THE FOLLOWING DEROGATIONS AND ADJUSTMENTS:**

- Swimming is allowed unrestricted, in the 300m area.
- Swimming is forbidden except in ZRUB (Zone reserved for the use of bathers). Getting closer to the city of Marseille to know ZRUB location.
- Transit allowed only to vehicles registered in port of the Counterfeit Currency and to propulsion engines human (paddle, kayak,...) of the Club nautique de l'anse de la Fausse Monnaie. Swimming allowed.
- In the 300 m area of the shore, swimming and the human-propelled machinery (paddle, kayak,...) are authorized.
- Authorized navigation only to clubs of sail of the Pointe Rouge.
- Ships propelled to engine are allowed to transit at a speed between 5 and 10 knots.
- Alternative Solution: Bypass the area of race from the west of Frioul islands.
- Buoys marking the area competition.
- Buoys marking the area of 300m.

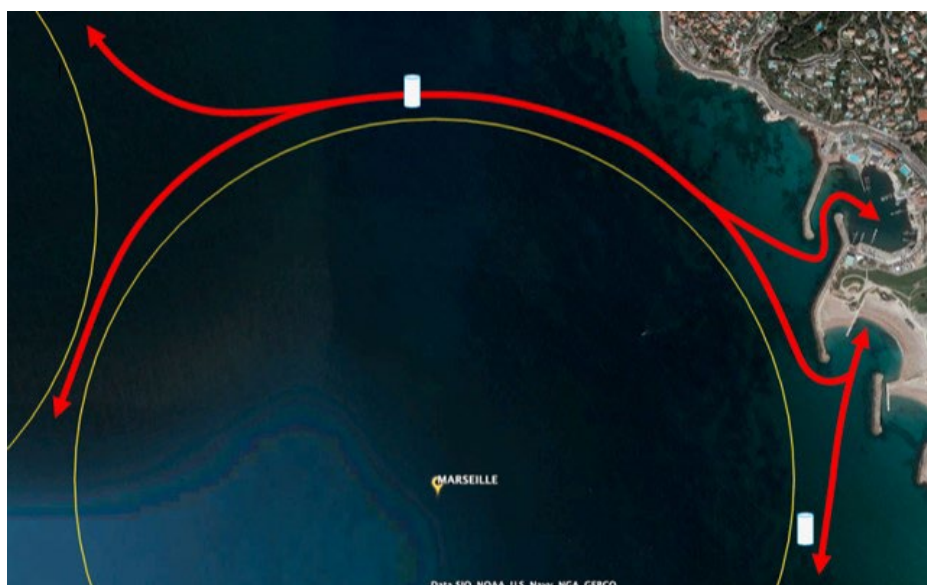
**FROM 7 TO 16 JULY 2023 ALL NAUTICAL ACTIVITIES (NAVIGATION, ANCHORAGE, SWIMMING, DIVING) ARE PROHIBITED FROM 8AM TO 8PM WITH THE FOLLOWING DEROGATIONS AND FACILITIES:**

- Swimming is allowed without restriction, in the 300m area.
- Swimming is prohibited except in ZRUB (Area reserved for swimmers). Getting closer to the city of Marseille to know the location of the ZRUB.
- Transit allowed only to the machines registered in the port of La Fausse Monnaie and to the machines with human propulsion (paddle, kayak,...) of the nautical club of the cove of La Fausse Monnaie. Swimming allowed.
- In the area of 300 m of the shoreline, swimming and human propulsion equipment (paddle, kayak,...) are allowed.
- Navigation allowed only at Pointe Rouge sailing clubs.
- Powered vessels are permitted to transit at a speed between 5 and 10 knots.
- Alternative solution: Bypass the running area by the western islands of Friuli.
- Buoys marking the competition zone.
- Buoys marking the 300m zone.

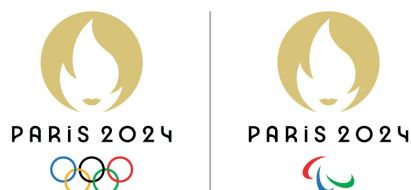
